The CEC is offering a Judges Course on April 15, in conjunction with the 2011 Canadian Bouldering Championships in Toronto at Climber's Rock from April 16-17, 2011.

Who is Eligible?

All interested people who have a basic knowledge of climbing and climbing competitions.

Part 2: 8:00-9:30pm

***For those who wish to achieve Local or Regional level JP certification (must also attend Part 1)**

There will be a written examination following the course. Registrants are expected to attend both days of the competition to judge and assist with JP duties under supervision.

Debriefing will occur at the end of each day to discuss problems and concerns.

Certification?

You will receive Local or Regional level Jury President (JP) certification, depending on previous experience. You must attend Part 1 and Part 2 to obtain JP certification.
